Summary:



Students stay in host families. They learn in official presentation about the partners countries and schools, get to know each other in icebreaker games. An important aim for the students in the program is for them to discuss their future international possibilities with each other rather than only discussing information about their individual countries.

Coordinators start to talk about the rules and aims for the future meetings.
